EDEN

Have you hear about our 2 year old unit which takes in children from the age of 2? If you would like to place your child please contact Tina our school EAL worker on 01274681961.

Our sessions run on a morning and an afternoon from 8.30am - 11.30am and also 12.15pm - 3.15pm. The children attend for five days a week which also helps them adapt to the routine before starting in nursery.

We encourage the children to participate in self registration on arrival. This is to develop their self-awareness and recognition of their own picture.

We have a spacious carpet area where we gather for circle time every morning to sing songs, learn our friend's names and look at very simple shapes and colours.





When the children have had their circle time we allow them to free play throughout the rest of the session exploring both indoors and outdoors with a free flow open door policy.



We are...

...part of St Columba's Catholic Primary School and so we teach our children about Jesus and retell the bible stories regularly. The children say a prayer at the beginning and at the end of the session and enjoy singing a

range of children's hymns. The children enjoy learning how to be caring towards others by learning about how Jesus was caring. The children join in with the celebrations across school such as the Nativity and Mother's day service.

Our Two Year Old room provides children to begin their education by learning through play. Fully qualified practitioners care for the children and support them through the beginning of their learning journey, the most important years of their lives.

We have small bathroom for the children to use and a nappy changing area for children who use nappies. We will support children through potty training and work alongside the parent for successful results. We have child level sinks to encourage independence and allow the children to wash their hands for snack and after messy activities.
